Additionally, you may submit quotations on a combo basis, if applicable, clearly indicating any discounts offered under such arrangements. Terms and Condition of selection of Newspaper and Agency for advertisement:

1. The Bank will take decisions regarding the selection of newspapers in which the advertisements will be published in each instance.
2. Based on Bank's discretion of selection of newspapers (both English and Bengali), the Agency which has quoted the lowest rate combining prices for the selected two newspapers (together) will be issued work order for publication. For example, Agency A has quoted Lowest price for selected Bengali Newspaper X and Agency B has quoted Lowest price for selected English Newspaper Y. However, Agency C has quoted Lowest Price combining the rates for selected Two Newspapers X & Y. In this scenario Agency C will be awarded the work order.





3. Bank will continue to take reference of the quotation throughout the current financial year and issue work orders. However, Bank reserve its right to revisit the process of selection of Vendor and Newspaper at any point of time of the financial year.

4. This arrangement shall be applicable for the financial year 2026–27 and will cover the Bank's Head Office and its 18 Regional Offices across the state of West Bengal. The Bank reserves the right to extend or shorten the timeline at its discretion.

5. Any agency, who **will miss the deadline of submission of quotation**, will not qualify for any further submission of quotation until Bank float new request for quotation at its own discretion.

6. Bank reserve every right to addition/alteration/modification in selection methodology of Newspaper and Vendors and any representation/query from any Vendor or Person in this regard will not be entertained.
